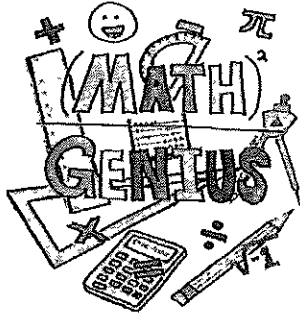

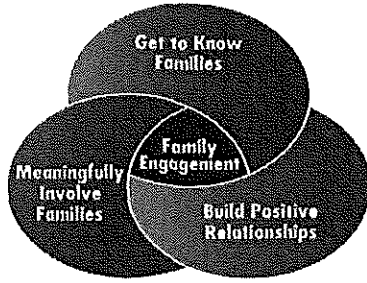

Dear Parent/Guardian:

We have set up vision screening for the month of November 2025.

Our screeners use an auto-refractor or Snellen chart, depending on age. This device allows us to screen faster and more accurately.

Since the auto-refractor looks like a hand-held camera, we can set up closer to the classroom and each individual screening takes less than 1 minute. The child is asked to look for a small red light from the device held 14 inches away from their face. Nothing touches the child.

**If you do not want your child screened – please let us know in writing.**

The nurses or the Lions Club will screen K4, K5, 5<sup>th</sup> graders and any special referrals.

The vision screening is done by MPS Nursing Program's nurses or the Lions Club and our goal is to finish the school's screening within the time frame selected.
