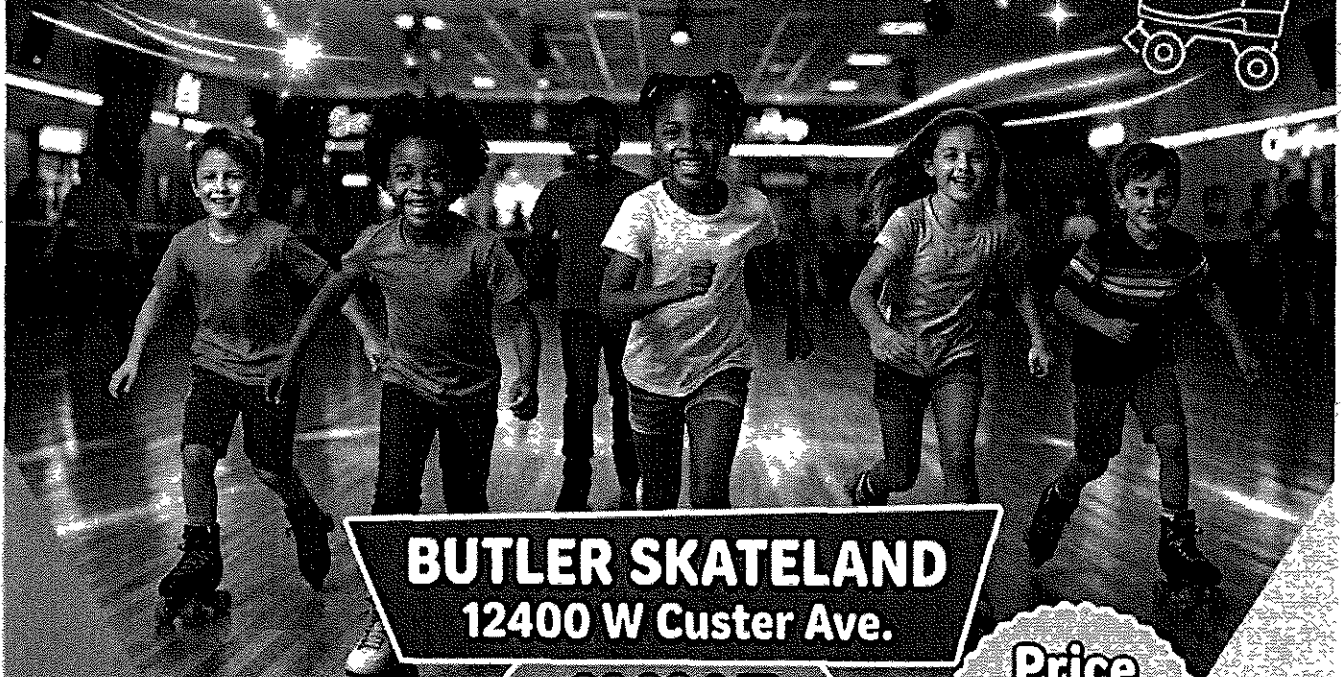

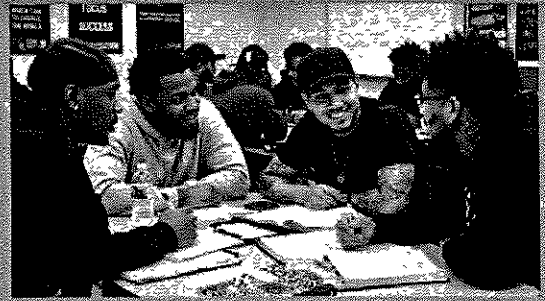


FATHERHOOD PROGRAM
