Dear Parents and Guardians,

We will soon be starting a new school year, and I am happy to have the opportunity to be your child's teacher. My name is Scott Polebitski and I will be your child's kindergarten teacher for the 2025 - 2026 school year! I am eagerly anticipating getting to know your child and watch them grow socially and academically over the next school year.

The first day of school for K5 students will vary depending on your child's last name (noted below). On your child's scheduled first day of school he/she will come to school with a parent(s) or family representative at 7:35 a.m. for an Orientation. The Orientation will be held in our multi-purpose room and will last until approximately 9:00 a.m. It's important for all K5's to be present at their scheduled Orientation to retain his/her seat. (Please call Whittier at 294-1400 if you no longer want your child to attend the K5 program at Whittier.) When the Orientation is over parents will leave and their K5 student will remain at school for the entire day.

Your child will be dismissed at 2:20 at the East Exit (doors at very back of school) on the first day and every day thereafter. Normal school hours are 7:35 AM – 2:20 PM. (Each morning, I will also meet the students on the playground, East Exit, at 7:35 AM.)

Please see the schedule below to determine your child's first day of school:

- **Tuesday, September 2nd** - **K5 students whose last name begins with A thru G attend school.**
(Student's whose last name starts with **H - Q** and **R - Z** stay home.)
- **Wed., September 3rd** - **K5 students whose last name begins with H thru Q attend school.**
(Student's whose last name begins with **A - G** and **R - Z** stay home.)
- **Thursday, September 4th** - **K5 students whose last name begins with R thru Z attend school.**
(Students whose last name begins with **A - G** and **H - Q** stay home.)
- **Friday, September 5th** - **ALL K5 students attend school.**

I look forward to meeting each of you and working with your child. Remember to join us for our Open House/Meet and Greet on Wednesday, August 27th, from 4:00 to 6:00 PM. It's a great way to get acquainted with other families, meet your child's teacher, and bring in your school supplies! We hope to see you there!

Entry and Dismissal

- There is no before or after school supervision on the playground. Students should not arrive to school before 7:30 AM.
- Parents can use the "Drop and Go" in the morning in front of the building and have your child go to the playground. Pull up as far as you can in the Drop and Go line. **DO NOT STOP YOUR ENGINE AND/OR GET OUT OF YOUR VEHICLE.**
- **Entry Bell – 7:35 AM** – Students should be in their designated line on the playground at 7:35 AM. Teachers will pick up students at 7:35 AM
- K4 thru 2nd graders enter & dismiss thru East Doors (Back of building)
K4 thru 2nd Graders will be dismissed to a parent at dismissal time.
- 3rd thru 5th graders enter & dismiss thru South Doors (South side of building)
3rd thru 5th grade parents can pick-up at South Doors or have their child meet them at their designated parking spot or use the "Get and Go" in the front of school beginning at 2:20 PM
- No Parking in front of school, across from school, in alley or in back parking lot.
- No students will be allowed to wait in the office if not picked up on time. In the event your child is not picked up on time; he/she will be directed to wait outside the front doors – unsupervised.
- **Travel only North bound on 3rd Street between Bottsford & Martin Lane during Drop-off and Pick-up times.**
- Respect our Crossing Guards and be courteous to our neighbors. Do not block driveways.
